



End of commercialisation and support of the ORIO AND JO robots

Escalquens, 13 of june 2026

Naïo hereby informs its customers, distributors and partners that it is discontinuing the commercialisation and manufacturer support of the Orio and Jo robots under the conditions set out below.

This decision covers:

- The definitive discontinuation of production of the Orio and Jo robots, previously designed and produced by the company Naïo Technologies ;
- The definitive discontinuation of associated software and hardware development ;
- The planned cessation of connected services and manufacturer support according to the schedule described in paragraph 2 ;
- Maintaining the operational status of equipment already in service according to paragraph 2 ;

I. End of commercialisation

From 1 June 2026, the Orio and Jo robots are no longer commercialised by Naïo. No new orders will be accepted by Naïo from that date.

Orio and Jo robots still available from partner distributors remain sold under the sole responsibility of those distributors, on the terms they determine. Those terms must incorporate the information contained on this page and the applicable liability transfer documentation.

II. Discontinuation of manufacturer support and connected services

From 1 June 2026, Naïo discontinues, for the Orio and Jo robots:

- support for the Enhanced Autonomy functionality;
- the creation and transmission of maps via the Naïo cloud, it being specified that users retain the ability to create maps locally and transfer them to the robot via USB key;
- the provision of new updates to the Naïo Companion application, version V25 remaining usable as-is without further support or development;
- where applicable, the GPS RTK navigation service;
- where applicable, the data transmission service associated with the SIM card subscription.

The Naïo infrastructure and servers dedicated to these robots will be permanently shut down on June 15, 2026.

Beyond that date, Orio and Jo robots in circulation will operate without connection to Naïo infrastructure, under the technical conditions described in the documentation provided individually to holders. Any use in a mode that does not comply with these conditions is carried



out under the exclusive responsibility of the user, Naïo disclaiming all liability for any damages resulting therefrom.

Any service or maintenance contracts currently in force will expire in accordance with their own contractual provisions, which Naïo will honour through to their expiry.

III. Conditions of use from the date of disengagement

From 1 June 2026, Orio and Jo robots in circulation may only be used:

- in supervised mode only;
- in accordance with the instructions of the original instruction manual, the requirements of which remain fully applicable;
- in compliance with the CE marking and the conditions of use for which the machine was designed and certified.

Naïo no longer maintains the autonomous mode of the Orio and Jo robots. Any use of the robot in this mode, regardless of its cause or technical modalities, is carried out under the exclusive responsibility of the user, Naïo disclaiming all liability for any damages resulting therefrom.

Any use in supervised mode without operator presence verification is only permitted within the framework of an exemption and liability transfer document signed between Naïo and the robot holder, under strict secured-plot conditions. This document is made available upon request at the address indicated in paragraph 6.

IV. Spare parts and training

Naïo may, subject to available stocks and without any commitment as to duration or continuity, supply certain spare parts and carry out occasional training interventions, upon express request and at the commercial rates applicable on the date of the request. This page does not constitute an offer or a commitment to supply on a continuous basis.

V. Transfer of ownership

In the event of any sale, rental, loan, or transfer of an Orio or Jo robot to a third party, the holder undertakes to transmit to the new user in full:

- the present information;
- the original instruction manual of the robot;
- any liability transfer or exemption document signed with Naïo.
